APIASA president Dr. Cirian Villavicencio delivered a state of APIASA address where he announced that Delta College had just been awarded the Asian American Native American Pacific Islander Institution (AANAPISI) Collaborative Federal Grant in partnership with Sacramento State, the Los Rios Colleges, and Sierra College.

This grant means that **Delta will be**receiving approximately \$200,000 over
the next five years to helping low-income,
first-generation AAPI students through their
transfer pathways as part of the EPIC
program

In addition, Dr. Villavicencio was also publicly recognized as the recipient of this academic year's Faculty Distinguished Award presented by the Academic Senate!



Filipino-American History Month Remembering Delta Alumna: Dr. Dawn Bohulano Mabalon (1972-2018)

Dr. Dawn Bohulano Mabalon was a passionate activist who dedicated her life to chronicling the rich Filipino-American history in California and across the U.S. She attended San Joaquin Delta College, transferred to UCLA, and completed her Ph.D. in American History at Stanford University. She was a professor of history at San Francisco State University, co-founder of the Little Manila Foundation, and a board member of the Filipino National Historical Society.



Her 2013 book -- "Little Manila Is in the Heart" -- charted the growth of the Filipino community in her hometown of Stockton, beginning with farm workers who came to pick crops in the early 20th century. The book includes her own family's story. Dawn tragically died after suffering an asthma attack while vacationing in Kauai. She was only 45.


