## **AP 4050.2 Credit for Articulated Courses**

- A. To receive credit for articulated courses at San Joaquin Delta College, students must:
  - 1. File an application for admission to San Joaquin Delta College.
  - 2. File an "Application for College Credit" with the Admissions and Records Department. The application is available in the Admissions and Records Department, the high school counseling office, and at the San Joaquin Delta College website (www.deltacollege.edu). The application must include an official record from the secondary school of all articulated courses.
  - 3. Request credit for an articulated course within two years of course completion, or no later than two years after high school graduation.
- B. College-credit will be entered on the student's official San Joaquin Delta College transcript.
  - 1. The San Joaquin Delta College transcript will reflect credit by examination credit for articulated courses.
  - 2. The grade awarded by the secondary faculty will be recorded on the Delta College transcript for the articulated course.
  - 3. The credit by examination limitations described in AP 4235 will not apply to secondary articulations. Articulated courses will be noted in the College data base for the purpose of reporting on secondary articulation. Units from articulated courses will not count toward the residency requirement for the Associate in Arts or the Associate in Science Degrees or the residency requirement for Certificate Programs.
  - 4. College fees will not be charged for college units earned through secondary articulated course work.
