2024-2025 Scholarship Descriptions

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP COUNCIL – CONTINUING- 14 @ 1,500

Scholarships awarded on the basis of excellence regardless of need. Students must have completed a minimum of 12 units at Delta, have at least a 3.75 cumulative Delta GPA, and plan to continue as full-time students in the upcoming fall semester. Students must submit a brief summary of Delta achievements and a statement regarding career goals.

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP COUNCIL – TRANSFER- 2 @ 1,000

Scholarships awarded on the basis of excellence regardless of need. Students must have at least a 3.75 cumulative Delta GPA, have been accepted to a four-year institution, and plan to enroll as a full-time student in the upcoming fall semester. Students must submit a brief summary of Delta achievements and a statement regarding career goals. This scholarship was established in 1987.

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP COUNCIL-INCOMING- 10 @ 500

Scholarships awarded on the basis of excellence regardless of need. Students must have at least a cumulative GPA of 3.75 and plan on attending Delta in the upcoming fall semester as a full-time student. Students must submit senior high school transcripts, a brief summary of high school achievements, and a statement regarding career goals. This scholarship was established in 1987.

ADAM R. DAWSON MEMORIAL- 1 @ 250

Psychology major, full-time status, minimum 2.75 GPA.

AFFIRM - 2 @ 500

Member of AFFIRM Program, meets or exceeds minimum requirements for program participation, attend at least one program activity/event per semester, volunteer minimum 10 hours per semester, SEP on file, maintain minimum 2.0 GPA.

AFRICAN-AMERICAN EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION- Awards Vary

African -American student, continuing education at SJDC, completing at least 24 units at end of spring semester, minimum 2.0 GPA.

ALFRED H. MULLER AUTO RESTORATION AWARD- \$500 Awards vary

Minimum GPA 2.0, Merit and work ethic-based scholarship. Applicant must receive a letter of recommendation from Larry Mariani to be considered.

ALFRED H. MULLER AWARD IN THEATER- \$500 Awards Vary

The award is based on excellent participation in drama productions onstage, backstage, and in the classroom during student senior year in high school or enrollment at San Joaquin Delta College. Incoming, continuing or transfer student. Must be enrolled in or have completed Drama 1 and/or Drama 19. Minimum GPA of 2.0. Letter of recommendation may be from a high school drama teacher. This is an annual scholarship award. Selection to be made by Muller family designee.

ALICE McINNES MEMORIAL- 1 @ 1,000

Female student. Liberal Arts major, shows exemplary character and record of good citizenship. Evidence of activities with interest, demonstrate leadership ability and experience in both school and community. Graduate from a Stockton Unified, Lincoln Unified or St. Mary's School District, two-year award, show financial need, minimum 3.7 GPA.

ALPHA PHI CHAPTER OF CHI ETA PHI SORORITY, INC. NURSING- 2 @ 1,000
African-American female or male who is currently enrolled in RN program, minimum 2.5 GPA.

ALPHA ZETA CHAPTER, DELTA KAPPA GAMMA INTERNATIONAL SOCIETY- Awards Vary
Female Education major, planning to become a teacher, resident of San Joaquin County for at least five years, demonstrate leadership ability and community involvement, transferring to a four-year institution in the fall, completed 30 units with a minimum 3.0 GPA at Delta College. This scholarship was established in 1999 by Alpha Zeta, Delta Kappa Gamma International Society of Educators with funds donated by Zeta Chapter's first president Ida Green. This scholarship is to be awarded to any female student who is going to become an educator.

AMADOR AND CALAVERAS COUNTIES RE-ENTRY STUDENT- 2 @ 1,300
Amador or Calaveras county resident, enrolled in at least 6 units, be at least 21 years of age, must show financial need.

AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF UNIVERSITY WOMEN- 3 @ 2,000
Female student earning a minimum of 60 transferable units by the end of the current spring term, with a minimum cumulative 3.50 GPA. Transferring to a four-year institution and attending full time starting in the fall term of the current year (upon verification of enrollment). Resident of San Joaquin County for at least five years.

AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY KARL ROSS UNIT #16- 1 @ 200
Female Veteran, 2nd semester at Delta College with plans to return to Delta as a full-time student.

ANGELA LEE DAVIS MEMORIAL- 1 @ 500
Student must be Black or African-American, and have a minimum GPA of 2.4. Student must be full time. Must be a transfer student. Established in 2021.

ASDC COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP FOR STUDENTS TO A UNIVERSITY- Awards Vary
The Associated Students of Delta College (ASDC) is offering scholarships to students who have demonstrated service and commitment to Delta College or Stockton community through participation in co-curricular activities. Transferring student must have a minimum 3.0 GPA, enrolled in 9 units when completing the scholarship application, and must have paid their \$10 spring, student activity fee. Established in 2012.

ASDC COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP- 8 @ Awards Vary
The Associated Students of Delta College (ASDC) is offering scholarships to students who have demonstrated service and commitment to Delta College or Stockton community through participation in co-curricular activities. Continuing SJDC Student must have a minimum 2.8 GPA, student must be enrolled in a minimum of 9 units, and the student must have paid their \$10 spring, student activity fee.

ASIAN PACIFIC ISLANDER AMERICAN STAFF ASSOC.- 3 @ 500
Asian Pacific Islander student, completed at least 12 units at SJDC, must submit one-page statement reflecting personal character, at least one letter of recommendation from instructor in major, minimum 3.0 GPA.

AVINASH RAINA MEMORIAL- 2 @ 500
Incoming Stagg High School graduate, valedictorian, salutatorian, national level speech competitor, Stagg Line Journalism Board or financial need student, minimum 3.0 GPA.

BARBARA CROCKER AWARD IN CULINARY ARTS- 2 @ 500
Student is enrolled in basic or advanced Culinary Arts Program, considering Culinary Arts career, minimum 3.0 GPA.

BEVERLY FITCH McCARTY- 1@1,000
Student must have a minimum GPA of 2.5. Student must have a financial need and merit. Student must be a female. Established in 2021

BRUCE DUKE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP – 1 @ 500

In memory of Bruce Duke and his two daughters, Cathy Anderson and Joanne Duke, The San Joaquin Potters' Guild awards this scholarship to an Art major, a student of Ceramics or Sculpture, who is transferring to a four-year institution in the fall. Applicant must submit a minimum of three pieces of art in a digital format, an artist's statement, and a letter of recommendation from a Delta College art instructor.

CALVIN RILEY MEMORIAL- Awards Vary

Baseball athlete, graduating sophomore, transferring to a four-year institution in the fall.

CAMRYN DWYER FOSTER YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP – 2 @ 500

This award is in memory of my foster daughter. It will be given to a person who is or ever was a foster child. I would like to know how the foster system affected their life. Student must keep a minimum 2.0 GPA, and both need and merit will be taken into consideration.

CCC FINISH LINE SCHOLARSHIP (formerly "Delta Completion" scholarship)- Awards vary

Eligibility Criteria:

Must have FAFSA/CADAA Application on File for the year applying for.

Must be CCPG Eligible

The student must be working towards a certificate, degree program or transfer to a four-year university

Must enroll in 12 units

Must have a 2.0 minimum GPA

The student must be at least ½ way through their goal based on a SEP on file

The student must be following their SEP

The student must have a realistic plan to finish the remainder of their goal within 2 years

Students pursuing a degree or transfer must also meet two of the three following criteria:

Have completed a transfer level English course

Have completed a transfer level math course

Have a GPA of 2.5 or higher

Must meet at least one of the following:

Filipino

Students in the fields that are regional workforce priorities, such as nursing or STEM, should be given preference

Requirements for the students awarded the scholarship:

The student must check in with a Counselor once per semester to make sure they are staying on track

The student must check in with their Resource Specialist once per semester

The student must maintain a 2.0GPA

CENTRAL STATE CREDIT UNION- 2 @ 1,000

Two members in good standing of CSCU, full-time incoming or continuing student, with a minimum 3.0 GPA. This scholarship was established in 2009.

CESAR CHAVEZ COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP- Awards Vary

In addition to the scholarship application, you MUST submit the following materials to be considered:

1. A one page, typed (double-spaced) essay entitled: "What Cesar Chavez Means to Me."

2. One or two letters verifying 40 hours of community volunteer service from a community service organization or governmental agency.

3. Two or more letters of recommendations from instructors.

This scholarship will be awarded to a full-time enrolled Spring graduate who is transferring to a four-year institution or a continuing full-time student at SJDC in the Fall. Applicants must be a son or daughter of a farm worker or other underprivileged background. Demonstrated leadership and/or community involvement is required as well as California residency, minimum 3.0 GPA.

CESAR CHAVEZ HIGH SCHOOL LEADERSHIP- Awards Vary

In addition to the scholarship application you MUST submit a one page, typed (double-spaced) essay entitled: "What Cesar Chavez Means to Me" to be considered.

This scholarship will be awarded to a high school graduate from Cesar Chavez High School enrolling full-time at San Joaquin Delta College with a high school GPA of 3.0 or above. Applicants must demonstrate leadership or community involvement and be a son or daughter of a farm worker or other underprivileged background.

CHESLEY I. COCHRAN (UNITED WAY EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR)- 1 @ 1,000

Enrolled in Social Administration, Human Services, and related fields, resident of San Joaquin County for previous five years, continuing or transferring student, previously involved in some phase of community service, must provide statement of residency and community involvement, minimum 3.0 GPA.

CHILD AND FAMILY STUDIES COUNCIL- 4 @ 500

Incoming or returning student who is a parent and enrolled in a program in the Health Sciences Division. One awarded to a day student and one to an evening student. Funds to be used for child care fees at the SJDC Child Development Center. Student must display academic achievement.

CHRIS WARDELL SCHOLARSHIP- 1@ 500

Scholarship is specifically for students majoring in accounting and transferring to a four-year college or university. Established in 2021.

CHRISTOPHER TAYLOR AND DAVID EDWARDS MEMORIAL ATHLETICS- 1 @ 100

Member of SJDC Baseball team, sophomore transferring to a four-year institution in the fall, recommended by Baseball coach.

CINDY JACKSON MEMORIAL, DELTA HELLENIC DANCERS- 1 @ 100

Dance, English, or Drama full-time student, Sponsor: John Pappas, minimum 2.8 GPA.

CLARENCE LOUIE APIASA FOUNDER SCHOLARSHIP- 1 @ 500

Asian Pacific Islander continuing Delta student, completed at least 12 units minimum GPA 3.0. Must submit a one-page statement reflecting personal character, leadership, extracurricular activities and community involvement. Must submit one letter of recommendation from an APIASA instructor, counselor or member.

CLINTON H. HULING MEMORIAL- 1 @ 200

Student transferring to a four-year institution in pursuit of an undergraduate degree in Sociology or social work, completed minimum 9 units in Sociology, full-time status at end of application, minimum 3.0 GPA.

DAMERON HOSPITAL FOUNDATION NURSING- 2 @ 250

Enrolled in ADN program, completion of 1st semester, Stockton resident, minimum 3.0 GPA.

DANIEL S.L. FONG MEMORIAL- 1 @ 1,000

Nursing student of East or Southeast Asian/Pacific Islander descent who has graduated from any San Joaquin County High School. The award will be based on both need and academic accomplishments. This scholarship was established in 2003. The Fong & Wills families benefited greatly from public education. Interest in Theatre or Music, financial need.

DEAN FELICE J. RODONI- 1 @ 500

Student completing last 45 units at SJDC and transferring to a four-year institution in coming fall, minimum 3.5 GPA.

DEBRA LOUIE E.P.I.C. SCHOLARSHIP- 2@ 500

Continuing Delta student participating in the EPIC learning community, completed at least 12 units, minimum GPA 3.0, financial need. Must complete a one-page statement reflecting personal character, e.g. leadership, extra-curricular, community involvement. Must submit one letter of recommendation from an EPIC professor or from instructor in major or counselor or APIASA member.

DELMAR AND BETTY MC COMB SCHOLARSHIP- 1 or 2 @ 1,000

Delta student transferring to UC Berkeley (ONLY) in the fall semester. Must show leadership and well-balanced interests. Student must have minimum GPA 3.0

DELTA COLLEGE BOOKSTORE SCHOLARSHIP BY PEPSI- 10 @ 500

New or reentry student with less than 24 units. Min GPA 2.0

DELTA DREAM- Awards Vary

Delta College Student or graduating high school senior planning to attend SJDC, must be an AB540 or DACA student, and must major in Spanish. Minimum GPA 2.0.

DENNIS ZAGAROLI MEMORIAL- Awards Vary

Must be an Architecture student who has demonstrated academic excellence and a desire to pursue a career in the field, completed at least one semester and currently enrolled at least half-time, intends to complete the Architecture AA degree and/or transfer to an accredited BA or BS Architecture program, must submit letter of recommendation from current Architecture instructor, minimum 3.0 GPA.

DENNISE HORTON MEMORIAL- 1 @ 100

Re-entry student, single parent, 30 years old or older, show financial need, minimum 2.0 GPA.

DIGHTON LITTLE MEMORIAL, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY DEPUTY SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION- 1 @ 100

Must be full-time Police Science major, show financial need, maintain minimum 3.0 GPA.

DISABILITY SUPPORT PROGRAMS AND SERVICES- Awards Vary

Student who has documented evidence of a physical, communication, learning, developmental or acquired brain injury disability and has completed at least 18 units of instruction at SJDC, minimum 2.5 GPA.

DISABLED AMERICAN VETERANS CHARITIES

Accepted into the registered nursing or health career program at SJDC, resident of Lodi School District, show financial need, minimum 3.0 GPA.

DOLORES HUERTA SCHOLASHIP- Awards Vary

Must be a continuing or transfer student, minimum 3.0 GPA, background in community and/or campus activism

DR. BETTY MATHEWS MEMORIAL- 1 @ 1,500

Must be an Electron Microscopy student who has demonstrated academic excellence, a desire to pursue technician training and placement, and who demonstrates leadership in the laboratory and the classroom settings, minimum 2.0 GPA.

DR. DAWN BOHULANO MABALON MEMORIAL- 1 @ 500

Major in History or Ethnic Studies or Political Science or Interdisciplinary Studies, Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences Option, AA. Student must be Asian, Filipino, Pacific Islander, or Other Asian. Minimum GPA 3.0

DR. JOE BISSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP – 1 @ 500

Students who took one or more history courses at Delta College. Minimum GPA 3.0. Letter of recommendation from a Delta College professor. Submit a written statement describing how studying history at Delta College has inspired you, changed your outlook and/or was a transformational experience. Briefly describe your educational goals.

Must be a full-time student, show financial need, minimum 3.5 GPA

DR. HENRY AND SYLVIA WONG RN- 2 @ 400 Amounts vary

Must be a full-time RN student, letter of recommendation from Nursing instructor/Director, minimum 3.5 GPA.

DR. HENRY AND SYLVIA WONG VETERAN IN HONOR OF ELIZABETH BLANCHARD- 2 @ 400 Amounts vary

Must be a full-time student, show financial need, minimum 3.5 GPA, must be a Veteran

DR. KATHY HART- 2 @ 1000

Student must be majoring in Technical Arts or CTE, show financial need, must be a full-time student, must be an incoming freshman

EDWARD AND JANE ZAVALA ELECTRON MICROSCOPY AWARD- 4 @ 500

Full time student, electron microscopy major, GPA 2.5, and financial need. Established in 2008.

EDWARD F. HURLEY MEMORIAL- \$500-\$1000 Amount varies

Incoming or continuing student, at least one of your parents employed in the construction trade, priority given to first generation students, show financial need.

ELEANOR COLE MEMORIAL PHYSICAL EDUCATION- 2 @ 500

Applicant must have been a member of an athletic team for one year at San Joaquin Delta College, graduating sophomore transferring to a four-year institution in the coming fall semester.

ELIZABETH M. HUMBARGAR MEMORIAL- 1 @ 500

Foreign Exchange student of Asian descent. AA degree candidate, transferring in the fall to a four-year institution, minimum 3.0 GPA.

ELSON T. BARNETT MEMORIAL- 1 @ 150

Second semester freshman or first semester sophomore majoring in Technical Arts or Apprenticeship and Trade Extension, must display interest, ability and potential in his/her occupational field, must be recommended by a Technical and Industrial instructor.

EMILY NANTT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP – 2 @ 500

To honor daughter of Taresa Nantt, a scholarship for teaching majors in memory of Emily Nantt. Must be a full-time, continuing student with a minimum 3.0 GPA.

ENGLISH MAJOR AWARD- 2 @ 250

English major, minimum 3.0 GPA, full time, continuing or transferring student, student must be a declared English major and have completed English 1B or 1D and 1 English elective

ERASTUS AND FLAVIA TRUJILLO-1 @ 500

Latino/Latina majoring in Sociology with the emphasis on Gerontology, submit Delta Staff reference letter, must be a 2nd year student at Delta College, community involvement, minimum 2.5 GPA.

Must be interested in Fire Science or Administration of Justice, demonstrated financial need.

FAUNA BREWER MEMORIAL-1 @ 200

Has student taken or is student currently enrolled in a math course at Delta College? If so, was student enrolled in a support class or seek academic tutoring for math? Provide additional statement regarding students need for support in math. Why did student need tutoring? Re-entry student, single parent, initially scored Math Level I on Assessment, minimum 2.0 GPA.

Professional or Vocational Technical Engineering major, transferring to a four-year institution in the fall, minimum 2.5 GPA.

FLOYD COLEMAN MEMORIAL, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY DEPUTY SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION- 1 @ 100

Must be enrolled full-time in the SJDC Police Academy, show financial need, maintain minimum 2.5 GPA.

FREDERICK W. 'FRED' REESE MEMORIAL, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY COORDINATING COUNCIL- 2 @ 250

Teaching or Public Safety major, transferring as a junior to a four-year institution in coming fall. Must submit written statement about yourself, including reason for entering teaching or public safety career, minimum 3.0 GPA.

GARY R. GRAY- 1 @\$1,000

Established in 2022 to honor the memory of Gary R. Gray, for an incoming or returning Delta student with financial need and a minimum 2.0 GPA, who identifies as LGBTQIA+.

GAYLE MCBRIDE PAY-IT-FORWARD- 1 @ 100

A student who demonstrates the same "Pay It Forward" philosophy as Gayle McBride. This student has received a hand along the way, be it financial or in facing their fears and has thus learned the significance of extending that same support and encouragement to others they may encounter in life. Short autobiography letter of interest, scored Level I on Math section of entry assessment or if math was taken after fall 2019 in co-requisite support course, re-entry student aged 30 years or older and a single parent, show financial need, minimum 2.0 GPA.

Full-time nursing certificates program student, three letters of personal reference, minimum 3.0 GPA.

GUSS G. SCHMIEDT MEMORIAL- 2 @ 400
Graduating high school senior from Manteca Unified School District, attending SJDC in the fall, majoring in Agriculture or Natural Resources Management. Apply with East Union high school counselor, Manteca high school counselor or Sierra high school counselor.

HAROLD H. BIALOSTOK MEMORIAL- 1 @ 150
Electronics major, completing first year at SJDC, continuing second year at SJDC, show creative project in mind, minimum 3.0 GPA.

HELEN DANNER MEMORIAL- 10 @ 1,000
Work 15-20 hours per week, continuing or transferring student, must maintain full-time status. An acknowledgment must be sent before disbursement of funds, minimum 3.25 GPA.

HELEN LAURA FLEMING MEMORIAL- 500 to 1,000 Amounts and awards vary
Incoming high school seniors and full-time returning SJDC students with interest in majoring in either mathematics or science. Submit at least one letter of recommendation from SJDC Math or Science Instructor or HS Mathematics or Science faculty teacher, 100 words or less essay on desire to pursue a major in Mathematics or Science, proposed mathematics or science full-time program (minimum 12 units required per semester at SJDC including a math or science course), show financial need, minimum 3.0 GPA.

HELEN STEIN MEMORIAL NURSING- 2 @ 500
Full-time Nursing student (9 units), completing first year at SJDC, continuing second year at SJDC, maximum GPA and units standing.

HUEY FAMILY MEMORIAL- 1@1,000
Chinese descent, full-time status, transferring to a four-year institution in the fall, participate in community service, two letters of recommendation (school and community) and short biography, minimum 3.0 GPA. This scholarship was established in 1987.

I AM/YO SOY SCHOLARSHIP- Awards vary

Music, Art or Education major, must be a full-time student, completed minimum 24 units, applicants must submit letter of recommendation from current instructor, must submit essay on what you want to teach and share goals and any experience, minimum 3.0 GPA.

JACKIE DeSANTI MEMORIAL- 1 @ 100

Member of San Joaquin Delta College Softball team, graduating sophomore transferring to a four-year institution in the fall, recommended by Softball coach, minimum 2.5 GPA.

JANE FRANCES VALTIERRA MEMORIAL- 1 @ 500

HIGH SCHOOL: Incoming high school senior from Edison, Mexican American descent, maintain full-time status, Stockton resident.
