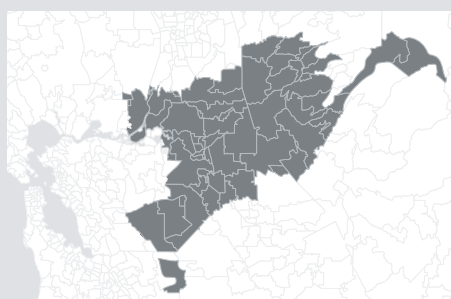

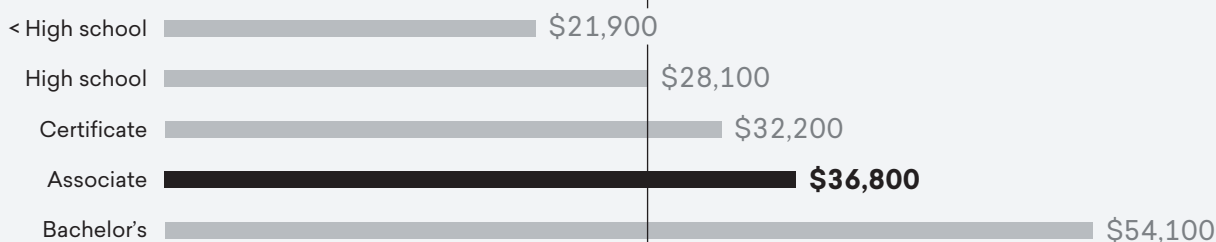


The Delta College Service Area, California

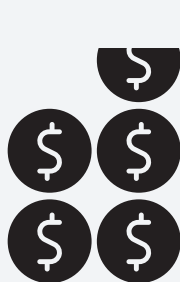


INVESTMENT ANALYSIS

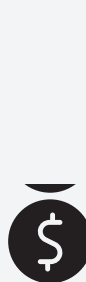
The average associate degree graduate from Delta College will see an increase in earnings of **\$8,700** each year compared to a person with a high school diploma or equivalent working in California.
