



Psychiatric Technician Program Prerequisites

The Psychiatric Technician program prerequisites are:

- Biology 31 (Human Anatomy) **OR** Biology 33 (Anatomy and Physiology)
- Psychology 1 - General Psychology
- Health Science 19/FCS 19 - Human Development
- Health Science 36 - Medical Terminology and Speech

ALL prerequisite courses **MUST** be completed with a grade of "C" or better and a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 at the time of applying to the Psychiatric Technician program.

In addition to the above, PT applicants must:

- Be at least 18 years of age
 - Provide a valid signed copy of your Social Security card
 - Provide proof of completion of High School (12th Grade) – Copy of HS Diploma or Official HS transcripts with a graduation date
- OR**
- Provide a copy of GED certificate

If a student has a High School diploma from a foreign country, a Sealed Official Evaluation must accompany that foreign High School diploma that indicates it is equivalent to a U.S. Twelfth (12th) Grade High School completion.

The agency evaluating the foreign diploma must be accredited by National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES).
