Today, as business ends at San Joaquin Delta College, the president's office and police department are closely monitoring the weather and its effect on our campuses.

With the weather severity forecast to increase over the evening hours, we will increase our efforts to ensure the campus remains safe. In the event the weather causes what is determined to be, unsafe conditions, we will send out an updated message to all employees of a campus closure.

As it stands now, the District will be open for business tomorrow, Thursday, January 5th, 2023.
